<u>ORDER</u>

At its September 2022 Session, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved an increase to the maximum page per original and copy transcript fee rates for fiscal year 2025, effective October 1, 2024.

The Schedule of Maximum Transcript Rates for all categories of transcripts for fiscal year 2025 is as follows:

Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of fees; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.	One feed. ¹ , \$3.70 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.55 per page; five or more fees, \$1.80 per page.	n/a	n/a
