
**PRETRIAL ORDER # 55**  
(Selection of Cases for Discovery Group 2)

In accordance with PTO # 49 (Discovery Scheduling Order for Group 2 Cases), the parties each submitted a list of six cases for inclusion into Group 2, from which the court was to choose five cases. The parties subsequently submitted letters/briefs in support of their recommendations and responses to opposing recommendations. The court notes that defendants substituted two names on their original list, with the consent of plaintiffs. The court has reviewed the submissions and **ORDERS** that the following cases are selected to constitute the initial cases in Discovery Group 2:

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2187 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:12-cv-06378. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
