PRETRIAL ORDER # 27
(Payment of Reasonable Expenses re
Granting of Motion to Compel)

By Pretrial Order # 24 (ECF No. 326), the court granted the plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Production of Documents Outside the United States. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 37(a)(5), the plaintiffs filed their affidavits of reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred in making the motion, and the defendant was given an opportunity to be heard. The parties have agreed that the plaintiffs' reasonable expenses total \$30,000, which will be paid by American Medical Systems, Inc. It is hereby **ORDERED** that the defendant shall pay \$30,000 to counsel for the plaintiffs within 15 days of entry of this Order.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:12-cv-08029. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or

transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the court's website at www.wvsc.uscourts.gov.
