PRETRIAL ORDER # 47


(Interim Order re Plaintiffs' Motions to Compel Nos. 452 and 457)

Pending before the court are the plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Depositions, Production of Custodial Files and Additional Discovery (ECF No. 452), and the plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Compliance with PTO # 24 and for an Order Setting a Date for Final Production of Outside the U.S. Documents (ECF No. 457). The defendant has responded in opposition and the plaintiffs have filed replies. A hearing to consider the motions was set for Wednesday, March 6, 2013, but, due to inclement weather, it was necessary to continue the hearing to March 21, 2013 at 1:00 p.m.

A portion of the relief sought by the plaintiffs is a Rule 30(b)(6) deposition relating to the defendant's production of documents. After review of the parties' submissions and in light of the continuance of the hearing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the plaintiffs' request for a Rule 30(b)(6) deposition of the defendant is granted, said deposition to take place no later than March 19, 2013, so that the parties can report to the court at the hearing on March 21, 2013. The deposition shall include efforts to locate and produce so-called "Outside the U.S." documents.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:13-cv-04226. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court. The orders may be accessed through the CM/ECF system or the court's website at www.wvsc.uscourts.gov.
