(Order re: AMS's Motion to Strike Plaintiffs' Discovery Pool Choices [ECF 482])


Pending is Defendant American Medical Systems, Inc.'s Motion to Strike Plaintiffs' Multi-Product, Pelvic Organ Prolapse Picks for Bellwether Discovery pursuant to Pretrial Order # 37 (Docket Control Order), filed February 27, 2013. [ECF 482.] Plaintiffs responded [ECF 492] and AMS replied [ECF 495].

For reasons appearing to the court, it is **ORDERED** that Defendant American Medical Systems, Inc.'s Motion to Strike Plaintiffs' Multi-Product, Pelvic Organ Prolapse Picks for Bellwether Discovery pursuant to Pretrial Order # 37 (Docket Control Order) is **DENIED**.

The court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2325 and it shall apply to each member related case previously transferred to, removed to, or filed in this district, which includes counsel in all member cases up to and including civil action number 2:13-cv-05722. In cases subsequently filed in this district, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action at the time of filing of the complaint. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent

pretrial order will be provided by the Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
