
(Hearing on Motion to Deem Requests for Admission Admitted or Compel:

Upon the request of the parties, and for good cause shown, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the hearing on the above motions currently scheduled for Wednesday, April 23, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. is hereby canceled and shall be rescheduled for **Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.** before the undersigned United States Magistrate Judge in Courtroom 102, of the Sidney L. In cases subsequently removed or transferred to this court, a copy of the most recent pretrial order will be provided by the

Clerk to counsel appearing in each new action upon removal or transfer. It shall be the responsibility of the parties to review and abide by all pretrial orders previously entered by the court.
