**PRETRIAL ORDER # 135  
(Order re: Mandatory Settlement Conference  
for Certain Plaintiffs with Claims involving Biologic Products)**

Pursuant to Pretrial Order # 134, counsel recently provided a joint written report to the court identifying those cases with claims involving biologic products (Suspend-Tutoplast Processed Fascia Lata and/or the Axis-Tutoplast Processed Dermis) that remain in the Coloplast MDL despite good faith discussions contemplated in PTO # 134 over the past several weeks. In PTO # 134, I stated that by today, I would enter an order identifying the cases wherein a mandatory settlement conference will be conducted beginning **August 23, 2017** “and continuing from day-to-day thereafter.” ECF No. 1448, Pretrial Order # 134, p. 2. Upon consideration of the written report submitted to the court, the court **ORDERS** that the settlement conferences will be conducted in the cases identified on Exhibit A beginning on **August 23, 2017**, at **9:00 a.m.** in Room 7800 and continuing from day-to-day thereafter. Parties should come prepared for evening work.


The court further **ORDERS** that (1) individual plaintiffs whose cases are scheduled for a settlement conference shall appear in person for the settlement conference with counsel of record

as reflected on the docket sheet for that plaintiff's individual case; and (2) any plaintiff who fails to comply with this PTO may be subject to a substantial sanction, including dismissal with prejudice.

Finally, the court **ORDERS** that if the parties reach a settlement in a case listed on Exhibit A, submission of an inactive docket order or dismissal order for that case will relieve plaintiff and her counsel from the obligation of attending the mandatory settlement conference.

The Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to file a copy of this order in 2:12-md-2387 and in the cases identified in Exhibit A.
